General Subjects and Management Report: A unit owner on a payment plan is keeping up with the payments.

The Board will get lease renewals from some unit owners who have failed to provide them. The Board reminds unit owners who are renting out their units that they are obliged to provide up to date leases to the Association

The Building Engineer will co-ordinate with residents to treat their kitchen drains with enzymatic drain cleaner. The cleaner must be applied in the evening so that the drains can remain unused for eight hours.

The Board approved a request from a unit owner to install a dishwasher, a garbage disposal and a new electrical panel.

There was a leak in a bathroom in the 01 tier that damaged the Building Engineer's apartment, unit 101. HHCA rules call for the unit where the leak occurred to pay for repairs to affected units. This obligation is on the unit owner regardless of whether the unit owner's insurance company agrees to pay for the damage.

Various Projects: The Board discussed the reserve study from Full Circle Architects. The Association is in very good financial condition and should be able to carry out all necessary maintenance without special assessments. After a final clarification, the Board will approve the study and the Board President will prepare an executive summary of the engineering and reserve studies for unit owners.

Everywhere Wireless will begin installation of building internet components this Fall. They will co-ordinate with the Building Engineer and residents about access to units.

COVID-19: The Association reminds residents that everyone, vaccinated or not, should wear a mask in common areas of the building.
